James 4:8 (NLT) "Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world."

I love God's system. It is easily understood by even me. It goes like this, "Seek Me and you will find Me" (When you seek me with your whole heart). Or as in the Scripture above states, "Draw near to God and God will draw near to you". It is so simple. Broken down to everyday speech, God will be as much involved in your life as you want.
